West Palm Beach, Fla. – PDSHeart,® Inc., a national leader in the delivery of cardiac telemedicine, today announced the acquisition of the cardiac event, holter and pacemaker monitoring business of TransMedEx, LLC, of Long Island, NY. The move continues PDSHeart's expansion of its cardiac monitoring services in the Northeast, combining its commitment to quality and technological expertise with the long-standing reputation of TransMedEx for premium remote cardiac monitoring services.

Founded in 2000, PDSHeart is the first telemedicine company to be accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO) and one of the country's leading providers of cardiac event monitoring services. It provides physician-prescribed remote and ambulatory care monitoring of non-symptomatic and symptomatic arrhythmia detection via landline, cellular telephone and the Internet.
